Narrative Description of Property: This is an early 20th Century. Two story colonial revival. It is three bays wide and two bays deep. The front double door has sidelights. The porch which spans the front of the house has grouped columns (3) supported by stone pillars. The hipped roof has asphalt shingles and two brick chimneys. There is a Palladian style attic window in the center attic dormer. The house is vinyl sided. Pilasters are on the corners of the house. There is a round window on the east side with keystones and molding. The south elevation has a bay window from the first to second floor. The foundation has shaped concrete blocks. There is a small back porch. A garage is located in the rear.

Significance: The criteria of eligibility are associated to Criterion A & C (Properties significant for its association in or linkage to events, and architecture/artistic value) for its significance to the history of Northampton / Northville and its last stage of growth and is an excellent example of a Colonial Revival with a Palladian style attic window.

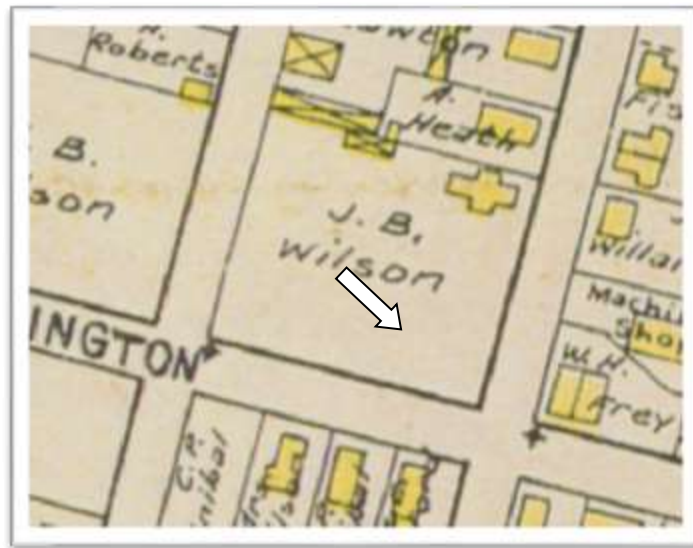

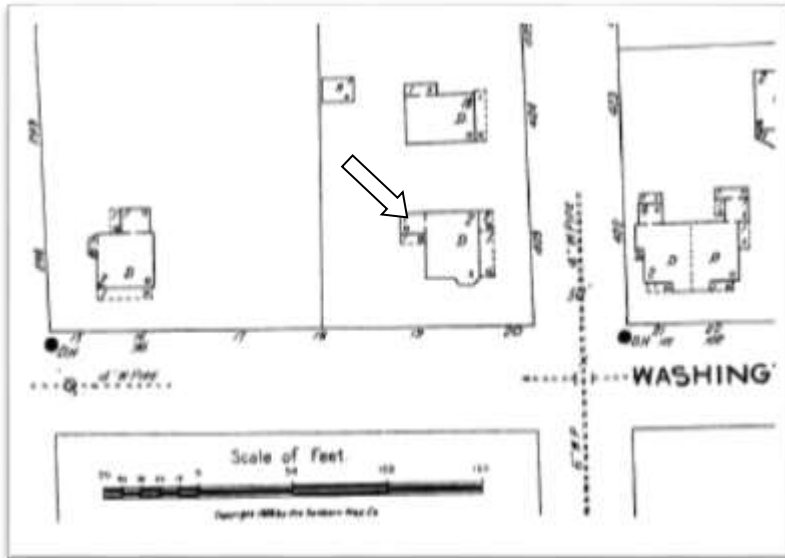
