Narrative Description of Property: This 1 ½ story wood framed home is built in the Craftsman style. There is a center dormer with 3 windows. There is a small center front porch with arched openings. On either side of the porch there is a group of 3 windows. There is a small addition on the south elevation.

Significance: The criteria of eligibility are associated to Criterion A & C (Properties significant for its association in or linkage to events, and architecture/artistic value) for its significance to the history of Northampton / Northville and its last stages of growth during its most significant time and as an excellent example of a Craftsman style cottage.
