Narrative Description of Property: This 2 ½ story wood framed home is built in the Victorian style. It has a gabled ended façade and is cross gabled in the center. The windows are slightly narrow 1/1 dbl hung wood. The attic window is the original 9/1 dbl hung wood window with colored glass on the top sash. There is a wrap around front porch supported by square columns. The front entry has a single wood door with glass. There are wood shutters.

Significance : The criteria of eligibility are associated to Criterion A & C (Properties significant for their association in or linkage to events and architecture/artistic value) for its significance to the history of Northville and for its integrity and character as a prime example of a simplistic Victorian style typical of Northville. Not many maintain this level or integrity.
