

KERR HOUSE  
(Dr. George Dasher)

According to 1868 map Joseph Spier owned the land, but no building was on it at that time. We believe this house was built circa 1898 - 1900 by a man from NY City named Kerr for his 2 unmarried sisters. When it was done he liked it so much he wanted it for himself so he built another similar to it on 1st street. (Conover house)

Very well built, thick cellar walls, heavy carrying beams, exceptional sturdy construction through out.

Interior wood work is Georgia Pine, doors are solid wood.

Exceptionally wide solid front door. (probably to allow passage for caskets)

2 working fireplaces

Walk in cedar closet on 3 rd floor

3rd floor servants quarters

A call box is still in the kitchen

It is said that the master bedroom on the 2nd floor has a walk in dressing room/ wardrobe with triple windows for plenty of light to identify colors when selecting clothes.
